As we all work with the after-school children we have decided to share this role between us with the different activities and experiences that we each can offer to them. Clare will be taking on the lead in this area with any administration.

Belinda will then take over from Clare in the nursery room, this age group of children is where Belinda has most of her experience. We hope you join us in welcoming her to our setting.

All Keyworker groups can be found in the rooms - if you are unsure of who your child's key worker is then please feel free to ask.

We are always looking to work closely with parents for the best possible outcomes for your child so therefore if you have anything you would like to share with us then please do so.

Can we please remind parents that all booked sessions need to be paid for and any time your child is here outside of those booked times will be chargeable. This also includes your funded hours, even if all hours are not used, as staff hours are done accordingly to your requirements. If additional times are required please speak to a member of staff to see if we can accommodate, this is for safeguarding reasons with regards to remaining within our ratios.

Parent and child packs will be sent out shortly so we can share the learning at home, there will be guidance inside the pack to help you. We hope you find these informative and use them with your child.

We will be holding our Christmas Concert / Parent Afternoon on Tuesday 18th December 1.00-3.00, the children will be learning many songs so we can entertain you and as always lots of fun activities and refreshments will be available.

The Christmas parties for all will take place on Wednesday 19th December 9.00-3.00 for all nursery and pre-school children and 3.15-5.30 for after-school. This day is free of charge and all we ask is that you bring in a food item. Please inform a member of staff if your child will be attending and pick a food lotto. We will be joining in with school and the entertainer who will be attending that afternoon.
