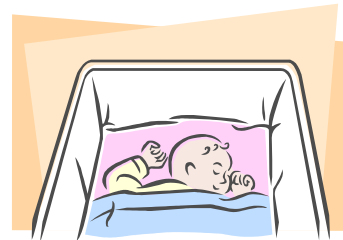
Everyone settled and it's time to play. We have a selection of age appropriate toys especially for your baby to play with.
